If you are interested in church membership or are wishing to transfer from another congregation, then again, please contact either of our ministers.

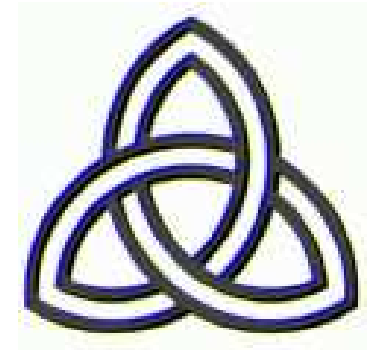
