Pray for all those who are experiencing difficult times in their lives. Pray that they might know God's peace as they seek His guidance

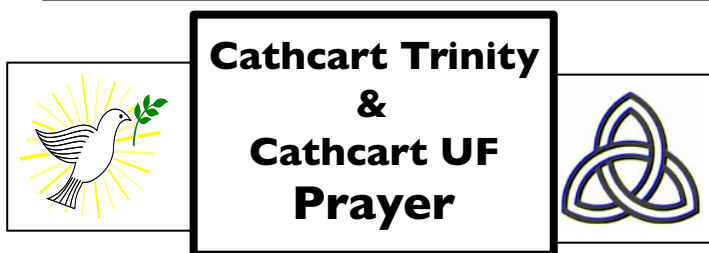
